ABOUT US:

The Hampton Terrace Community Association is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization founded in 2016 by a group of caring and dedicated neighbors who recognized a need for a neighbor's association that was inclusive, transparent and above all actively engaged with its neighbors and businesses. We do not charge membership fees- all residents of Hampton Terrace are automatically members. Funding for the association is raised via donations, sponsorships, and events, like the Seminole Heights Great Pumpkin Patch - our largest fundraiser of the year!

Seminole Heights United Methodist Church was founded in 1921. Our present yellow brick building at the corner of Central and Hanna was completed in 1928, and we have been a pillar of the Seminole Heights community ever since. Our mission is to be "A community of faith led by God in service to Seminole Heights and the world." We take our mission seriously, engaging in service through partnerships with local schools, neighborhood associations, and nonprofits for the benefit of our neighbors near and far. We gather for weekly worship on Sundays at 10:30am, and we host neighborhood and community groups seven days per week in our historic building.

ABOUT THE EVENT:

The Seminole Heights Great Pumpkin Patch was started over a decade ago by a SHUMC family. In 2020, the HTCA began partnering with SHUMC to build an even bigger and better patch.

Our pumpkin patch is open from October 6th through October 31st and is the largest full season pumpkin patch in the City of Tampa. We attract visitors from all over Florida, are a destination for many local influencers, and see upwards of 10,000 visitors over the course of the month. Last year, we sold 8,899 pumpkins of all shapes and sizes!

The pumpkin patch also hosts events throughout the season including: Movie Nights, Kids Pumpkin Painting, Character Meet & Greets, First Responders Day, Pets at the Patch, and more!
